## **QUALIFICATION B.S.P.S. 64/09**

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S.) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the constitution and rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

### **2010 B.S.P.S. SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS – (SATURDAY)**

This show is a qualifier for the 2010 B.S.P.S. Championships show to be held at Arena UK. Qualification rules will be subject to the rules of the 2010 Championship show but are expected to be the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners only in Working Hunter and Show Hunter type and Cradle Stakes and Heritage and the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners in the Intermediate Show Riding Type, will qualify. In mixed height classes the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> placed ponies will qualify provided the animal is registered and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member in accordance with Rules 23 and 28.0

### **THE BSPS TRAVEL TRUST ASSOCIATION CHALLENGE**

All shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S. are qualifiers for the Travel Trust Association Challenge Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Open Working Hunter Ponies and Open Show Hunter Ponies, Cradle stakes, Open Nursery Stakes, Intermediates, Heritage and LR of HT.

The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the B.S.P.S. 2009 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the 'Travel Trust Association' Challenge' the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

If after qualifying a pony for the B.S.P.S. Horse of the Year Show it will forfeit it's qualification for the 'Travel Trust Association Challenge'.

### **HERITAGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**

The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize winners in the appropriate classes will qualify for the HERITAGE CHAMPIONSHIP at the B.S.P.S. Championship Show. Owners and riders MUST be either B.S.P.S. members or B.S.P.S. Heritage Members to enter. Ponies should be registered in the Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A & B, Highland, Fell, Dale, Connemara and Welsh C & D.

### **THE B.S.P.S. PREMIER LEAGUE**

This show is a qualifier for the "B.S.P.S. Premier League", the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> placed ponies in the Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128 cms., 133 cms., 148 cms. Show Pony, Lead Rein Hunter Type, 122 cms., 133 cms., 143 cms. and 153 cms. Show Hunter Pony and Cradle and Nursery Stakes, 133cms., 143 cms, and 153 cms. Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter and Working Hunter Classes.

Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBAND, R.I.H.S., (including Home Produced qualifying classes), H.O.Y.S. and DENNYBECK CLASSIC

### **B.S.P.S. "BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" RIDER OF THE YEAR**

The best rider in each of the following Open Classes at all B.S.P.S. Affiliated Shows will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the final at the Summer Championship Show – Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, 122, 133, 143 & 153 S.H.P., Cradle takes, Nursery Stakes, 133 143 & 153 W.H.P. Intermediate S.R.T., S.H. & W.H. classes, Open Heritage Classes and L. R. of H.T.

## **THE BLUE RIBAND PONY OF THE YEAR (SUNDAY)**

This show is a qualifier for the B.S.P.S. Blue Riband Pony of the Year; the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in the Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open Show Hunter Pony, Open Working Hunter Pony classes will qualify. Also the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> from Intermediate Working Hunter, SRT and SH.

## **HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW – (SUNDAY)**

This show is a qualifier for the **Horse of the Year Show 2009**. Only one pony in each of the three Open Show Pony, WHP, INT WHP, INT SRP, INT SH, Open Show Hunter Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type Class. Lead Rein and First Ridden classes qualify and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first five ponies placed in each class will qualify. Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. members and the pony registered with the B.S.P.S. to compete in classes with qualification for the H.O.Y.S. Obstacles will be used in the Lead Rein of Hunter Type Class.

The highest placed pony, (not already qualified) in each of the qualifying classes will qualify for the Horse of the Year Show held at the NEC in Birmingham from Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> of October until Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> of October 2009.

This show must collect a Horse of the Year Show contribution of £10.00 from each horse/pony entering a Horse of the Year Show qualifying class at the time of entry (the entry fee includes this contribution). No refund of any monies will be made at the show in respect of any starting or non-starting entrant for any reason whatsoever. Qualifiers are awarded solely at the discretion of the Horse of the Year Show and are subject to the conditions detailed above. Please note: The H.O.Y.S. qualification is subject to confirmation from the Horse of the Year Show

1. The Judges named in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge; the committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any judge who is unable to attend.
2. No nomination or substitute entries are allowed and no entry fee will be refunded.
3. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, servants, ponies or property in connection with or arising from this show.
4. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
5. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entries or entry to the Show.
6. Any trophy won at this show must be signed for and a £5 deposit paid. The deposit is refundable upon return of the trophy.
7. Competitors competing at any show which is run under the B.S.P.S rules must at all times when mounted be wearing a correctly secured British Standard skull cap/riding hat No's; EN1384, USA PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 accredited. See Rule 46 of the B.S.P.S rule book (2009).
8. DISCLAIMER –
  - (a) save for the death or personal injury to persons caused by the negligence of the organisers, the organisers of this event accepts no liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, owners, riders, spectators, land vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, howsoever caused.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

### **NPS/www.horsequest.co.uk Mountain & Moorland Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship**

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS.
